Two \$750.00 scholarships will be awarded. All applicants may apply again next year.

Scholarship awards will be sent to the accredited Post Secondary Institution upon verification of enrollment.

Applications must be received no later than April 15.

Awards will be announced to the members at the May VVA290 Chapter meeting. Award winners will be invited to attend a membership meeting later in the year to accept their scholarships.

Applicants who are not awarded a scholarship will be notified of the results provided a stamped, self addressed envelope is included with your application.

A committee of 5 Chapter 290 members in good standing will review all applications. Committee members must be impartial and have no familial connections to the applicants. Award decisions will be based upon the total points received from all reviews based upon the following categories:

Category	Maximum Points
* Neatness of the application	5
* Grade Point average	5
* Extra-curricular activities	10
* Public service activities	10
* Work experience	10
* Personal goals	10
* Essay contents	30
* Essay grammar, spelling and layout	20
<u>Total Maximum Points:</u>	<u>100 times 5 = 500</u>
