Kris Lawrence-Schumann made a motion for the Parent Council to donate a maximum of \$500 towards each event (prom and senior graduation party). Ann Herold seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mark Donlin suggested a monetary award be given to a teacher/support staff who exemplifies Christ and the school's mission during the student's time at Cathedral. It was suggested that just seniors vote and maybe the award could be handed out during the senior award ceremony. The discussion was tabled due to time constraints and will be put on April's agenda.

Sarah Jane Nicoll led the 9th grade class for Cathedral staff appreciation treats in February. They had Valentine's cupcakes and goodies. Ian Pfeiffer is leading the 8th grade class for March. She is planning a Mexican Fiesta lunch. Christina Oliver volunteered to lead the 7th grade class for April. Kris Lawrence-Schumann talked with Candace Waldoch about how to ensure that the kitchen staff gets to participate in the appreciation lunch. Candace said that setting up by 10 am will ensure this.
