*Size of the School - where do you see yourself?

*Cost - be realistic and discuss with your parents

*Admission Requirements - know the gpa and ACT score range of the current freshman class (academic profile) - where do you fit?

Reach Schools are ok

Niche.com - Website to research any college

Application Process

Applying On-Line

Individual school website - may take less time

Common Application - may be best for multiple schools

Request Transcripts:

- -electronic /Common App (e-mail will be sent to counselor)
- -paper transcripts request in counseling, time to process
- -senior schedule included

Be Aware of Deadlines!

-Early Action -Early Decision - binding, only at one school

Applications and Test Optional

ACT/SAT Scores - send from testing company - many now test optional -what does that mean for admission and scholarships?

Next ACT test:

October 28, 2023 - Deadline to register September 22nd

Resume

- Use "fill in" sheet or
- Create your own (sample)
- Copy will be kept in counseling office
- Essays Often Optional, but sometimes recommended
 - Proofread!! Ask a teacher or counselor
 - Keep copies of best writing

Recommendation letters

-Teachers -Coaches -Service Organizations *Allow Two Weeks Notice*

Application Deadlines!

University of Minnesota - Twin Cities

Early Action I Deadline and Nursing Program November 1st - for admission, University Honors Program, and scholarships (receive admission decision by January 31st)

Early Action II - December 1st, decision by Feb15th

Regular Deadline - January 1st full consideration for admission (receive decision by March 31st), Honors Program, and scholarships

Financial Aid - FAFSA Priority deadline March 1st - strongly encouraged to complete soon after October 1st.

Federal Financial Aid Form -

Determines:

- Grants Loans

- Work Study
- *You must use 2022 tax data when completing
- * Can set up account <u>Studentaid.gov</u>

Can complete starting December 1st - Earlier the better!!

Financial aid form used by some private colleges to award institutional aid.



Scholarships

- * Check Counseling Office and CHS Website for current information. (limited scholarship info now, but check back)
- *Ask Colleges where you are applying special applications, deadlines, ACT score requirements?
- * Check community agencies and parent's employers.
- * Be cautious about paying for scholarship services.
- * Local scholarship program in spring.
